

Constitution of the Grateful Dead Club

Santa Barbara City College

Article I – Name

The name of this organization shall be the **Grateful Dead Club of Santa Barbara City College (GDC)**.

Article II – Purpose

The purpose of the Grateful Dead Club is to bring together students who share an interest in the music, culture, history, and community surrounding the Grateful Dead. The Club seeks to foster creativity, inclusivity, and community through music appreciation, discussion, listening sessions, live event attendance, and related cultural activities.

Article III – Authority

The Grateful Dead Club derives its authority from the collective interest, participation, and passion of Santa Barbara City College students who share an appreciation for the music, culture, and community of the Grateful Dead. The Club operates in accordance with the policies and guidelines of the Santa Barbara City College Student Senate and the Board of Trustees.

Article IV – Membership

Membership is open to all currently enrolled Santa Barbara City College students regardless of race, color, religion, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, disability, or national origin, with hopes of being a deadhead, but it is not necessary! All are welcome.

Article V – Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club shall be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, Room CC 217. Special meetings may be called by the President as needed.

Article VI – Officers

The officers of the Club shall include:

- **President** - Presides over all meetings, represents the Club, and calls special meetings as necessary.
 - **Vice President** - Assists the President and assumes the President's duties in their absence.
 - **Secretary** - Records and maintains minutes of all meetings and handles Club correspondence.
 - **Treasurer** - Maintains financial records and manages Club funds in accordance with SBCC policies.

Article VII – Elections

Officers shall serve **one semester terms** and shall be elected during the **Start of each semester** by a majority vote of the active membership.

Article VIII – Amendments

This Constitution may be amended upon approval by at least **sixty percent (60%)** of the active Club membership present at a regular meeting, provided that notice of the proposed amendment has been given in advance.
